

WPCS Completes Major China Project and Announces \$6 Million in New Contracts

EXTON, PA – (PR Newswire – First Call) – May 21, 2007 WPCS International Incorporated (NASDAQ: WPCS), a leader in design-build engineering services for specialty communication systems and wireless infrastructure, has announced that, through its Taian AGS subsidiary, it has recently completed a major project for Guangzhou Gas Company. The project entailed the trenching and installation of an 800 meter distance pipeline crossing two narrow rivers in order to fuel residential and commercial businesses in Guangdong Province.

In addition, WPCS has received new contracts totaling approximately \$6 million that include projects to be completed for Yuba City California, Sprint Nextel, Crown Castle, PTAcess Networks, Avaya, GTSI, Somerset Medical Center, California Pacific Medical Center, Sonoma County Junior College, the Montgomery Department of Public Safety and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA).

Charles Madenford, Executive Vice President of WPCS, commented, "We are continuing to gain momentum here in the U.S. while expanding into China. The China market is developing its infrastructure and it is presenting many opportunities for WPCS and its Taian AGS subsidiary. Our goal is to expand our construction services to include specialty communication systems, which we anticipate will be in demand in China in the coming years. We also believe that China will represent an increasing portion of our overall revenues in the future."
